CONSTITUTIONAL REVISION OF THE INSTITUTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF SERBIA

Summary

In this paper, we displayed the analysis of the existing constitutional state in Republic of Serbia and we gave the perception of upcoming phase of constitutional development. Widely announced and expected constitutional revision in Serbia would probably affect various segments of constitutional matter, and the authors especially distinguish and point out the attractiveness of potential changes of constitutional solution of institution of president of Republic.
